Admission Requirements

- Complete application form through the link: www.hobefi.org/pre-registration
- Copy of non-refundable registration fee receipt of 10.000 FRs.
- A copy of GCE O/L or Probatoire (at least 4 papers).
- A copy of GCE A/L or Baccalaureate (at least 2 Papers).
- Copy of Birth Certificate.
- Two colour passport-sized photographs.

Duration of Training

The training duration ranges between one and three years depending on the trade and on the learning ability of each trainee.

Registration Procedure

For all academic programmes, registration is both online and on campus. Completed application forms are returned to the admission office of HOBEFI or through the school's email address.

- Train them in basic management skills, record keeping and entrepreneurial skills.
- Continuous monitoring and evaluation of graduates for some years for any possible backfilling.
- Set up a revolving micro finance scheme to benefit ex trainees with symbolic interest.

- a)** Be well equipped in at least one life skill that fully empowers them economically and socially.
- b)** Be armed with leadership and basic management skills to run a good business.
- c)** Start up a self-owned workshop.
