H4BF Youth Engagement Scholarship Program Terms and Conditions

1. Introduction

H4BF, in collaboration with HOBEFI, offers the "H4BF Youth Engagement Scholarship Program" to support motivated and promising young Cameroonians in pursuing vocational training at HOBEFI. This program aims to empower young people with valuable skills and knowledge, fostering their development and contributing to a brighter future for themselves and their communities.

2. Eligibility

- Applicants must be citizens of Cameroon between the ages of 17-25
- Applicants must demonstrate financial need and the inability to afford the full cost of training at HOBEFI.
- Applicants must possess a strong academic record and relevant skills for the chosen vocational program.
- Applicants must demonstrate a commitment to community engagement and a desire to contribute positively to their communities after graduation.

3. Scholarship Benefits and Responsibilities

- **Scholarship Coverage:** This scholarship will cover a percentage of the total tuition fees for the chosen vocational program at HOBEFI (80%).
- **Additional Benefits:** Depending on program availability and funding, the scholarship may offer additional benefits such as accommodation, learning materials, or transportation allowances.
- **Student Responsibilities:**
 - Maintain satisfactory academic performance of at least 50% throughout the program, as defined by HOBEFI's grading system
 - Demonstrate good conduct and adherence to HOBEFI's rules and regulations.
 - Actively participate in all program activities, including lectures, workshops, practical sessions, research and community engagement initiatives.
 - Complete the chosen vocational program within the designated timeframe.

- Upon graduation, actively contribute to their communities through volunteer work, entrepreneurship, or employment in their field of expertise for a minimum period of 1 year.

4. Selection Process

- A selection committee composed of representatives from H4BF and HOBEFI will review applications based on the eligibility criteria and merit.
- Shortlisted candidates may be called for interviews to assess their motivation, skills, and commitment to the program.
- The selection committee's decision will be final and cannot be contested.

5. Revocation of Scholarship

- The scholarship may be revoked if a student:
 - Fails to meet the academic performance requirements.
 - Engages in misconduct or violates HOBEFI's rules and regulations.
 - Demonstrates a lack of commitment to the program or community engagement initiatives.
 - Withdraws from the program without a valid reason.
 - Fails to fulfill the post-graduation community engagement requirement.
- In case of scholarship revocation, the student will be responsible for reimbursing the program the full or partial cost of the scholarship received, depending on the reason for revocation.

6. Disclaimer

H4BF and HOBEFI reserve the right to modify the scholarship program terms and conditions at any time without prior notice. Any changes will be communicated to the scholarship recipients.
